HUNTING TRIPS

A hunting trip to Canada can be very rewarding with a wide variety of game and terrain. Bear to waterfowl can be found in various regions of Canada. **Global Voyager** will provide details on your game upon request. There are some restrictions on the type of weapon one can bring; hunting rifles, shot guns as well as semiautomatic weapons as well as ammunition can be brought. Pistols, revolvers and automatic weapons are prohibited.

Mongolia offers hunting trips from the Gobi Desert to the Altai Mountains. One of the big game animals found is the ibex, which can be found in the mountains and the desert. There are two varieties found in Mongolia, the Altai ibex found in the Altai Mountains and the Gobi ibex found in the Gobi Desert. Sheep hunting is also available as well as the black-tailed gazelle. Another prized animal is the Mongolian elk and the Siberian roe deer. Other game includes – wolves, white gazelle, capercaillies (7-10 lb type of grouse) and migrating waterfowl found in the Great Lakes regions of Western Mongolia.

Is a Guide Necessary?

It is important to evaluate the experience of your hunting party to determine if an outfitter is necessary. One must evaluate if the party has a core group of hunters who have dealt with the terrain and animals that will be encountered on the trip. If the hunting trip party lacks experience either in the terrain or the game being tracked this can lead to an unsuccessful hunt or even a tragic one with someone being injured or worse.

Another advantage of using an outfitter for your hunting trip is that proper gear for the trip will be available. Depending on the game you are after the outfitter can supply you with equipment that would be very expensive for a single particular hunting trip. An experienced outfitter who will have the proper horses, supplies and vehicles that will be needed for a successful hunting trip; he will supply particular equipment for a particular environment.

Some outfitters offer access to areas that are not accessible to the general public. They usually they have scouted the area thoroughly for game which may not be possible for a "go it alone" hunter. The outfitter will have a thorough understanding of the game and terrain, which could be the difference between a successful and unsuccessful hunting trip.

One disadvantage of using an outfitter is that you are usually booked and locked into a time schedule that regulates your activities. On your own your hunting trip is more flexible since you can change locations, times you hunt or just go for a pleasant hike anytime you want.

The cost of a hunting trip with an outfitter will be expensive but the advantages by using one may be worth it. Some costs such as licenses, groceries, transportation, and accommodations will be incurred if you do it alone. It may be that a hunting trip with an outfitter will allow you to go on one trip rather than a few but if you are inexperienced with the game or terrain it may be worth using the outfitter and enjoy that one experience instead of having a string of unsuccessful hunts on your own.
